FORT BUFORD STATE HISTORIC SITE

Fort Buford was a military post established at the confluence of the Yellowstone and Missouri Rivers in 1866. History includes Buffalo Soldiers, Nez Perce Chief Joseph and the Sioux Hunkpapa Sitting Bull.

FORT UNION TRADING POSTS NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

From 1829-1867, Fort Union dominated the fur trade on the Upper Missouri River. Built near the confluence of the Yellowstone and Missouri Rivers by John Jacob Astor's powerful American Fur Company.
