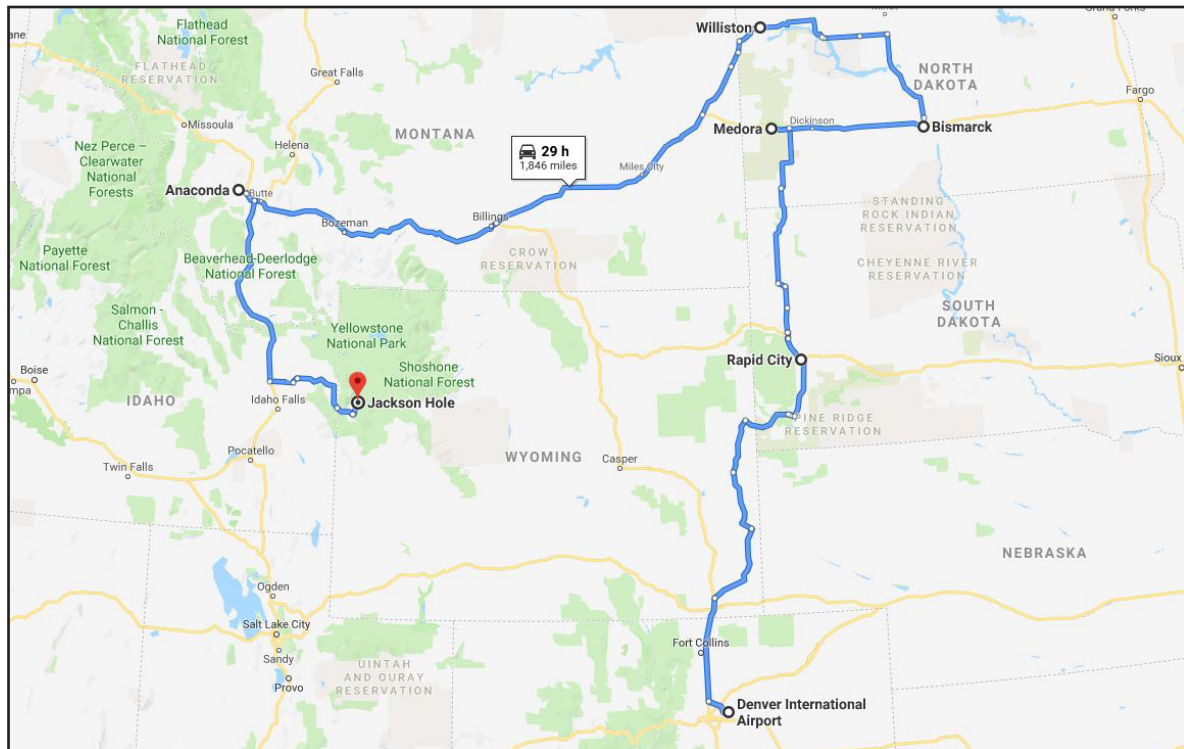

Route: Denver, South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana, Wyoming

There are hundreds of excellent golf courses throughout the region, and golfers are constantly surprised at what they can find in places they never thought possible. They're also surprised to find out that they can play golf on many courses six to seven months a year amid national parks and spectacular scenery.

Days 1/2 – Arrive Denver

It's true; the ball really does go farther up here. But golf in Colorado is about more than the extra ten yards off the tee. It's about spectacular championship layouts set against equally spectacular backdrops. You can even swing over to one of the PGA's most unique and challenging tournaments, The International, attracting the world's top golfers. Overnight in Denver

Days 3/6 – Denver to Black Hills

The Black Hills of South Dakota features several fine courses including the 18-hole par 72 Meadowbrook course in Rapid City that's rated in the top 50 public courses in the nation. Southern Hills Golf Course west of Hot Springs is a nine-hole course chosen by the National Golf Foundation as one of the best in America's heartland, and Dakota Dunes, designed by Arnold Palmer, has been named the best course in South Dakota by Golf Digest and Golfweek. Overnight Rapid City and Hot Springs

Days 7/9 – Black Hills to North Dakota

Triple Challenge - New and unique for 2006, Hawktree Golf Club has joined with two other outstanding North Dakota golf clubs; Bully Pulpit Golf Club, near Historic Medora, this 18-hole course is set in the beautiful North Dakota Badlands; The Links of North Dakota, near Williston, is a true links style course; to provide an unbelievable opportunity for golfers that are ready for a real challenge. Overnights in Bismarck, Williston, and Medora
