

Western North Dakota

Black Sands Golf Course

This 9-hole, par-35 course in the state's coal mining region gets its name from black coal slag bunkers. Water and grass bunkers test your shot-making skills.

2 Bully Pulpit Golf Course

This 18-hole course along the Little Missouri River nestled in the jagged buttes of the Badlands has been named No. 1 in Golf Digest's rating of "New Affordable Courses." Holes play in woodlands, meadows and the most scenic, high above the river in the Badlands.

3 Edgewater Country Club

This course on the Fort Berthold Reservation outside of New Town offers nine challenging holes overlooking Lake Sakakawea and the area's rugged buttes.

4 Fox Hills Golf and Country Club

A premier 9-hole course with multiple tee boxes in the heart of the Bakken oil field, Fox Hills features wide open vistas of the rugged surrounding area.

5 Gateway Cities Golf Club

S. Railway Portal, ND 58772 701-926-3145

Situated on the US/Canadian border, this course offers eight holes in Canada and one in the United States. The course is flat with large greens and only one dogleg fairway.

6 Heart River Golf Course

The scenic Heart River winds through this course, which actually is two courses in one: the more wide-open top side and tree-lined bottom with river in play on most holes.

Medicine Hole Golf Course

With great views of the Killdeer Mountains and surrounding area, this 9-hole course takes full advantage of the natural terrain, water and native grasses.

The Links of North Dakota

This nationally recognized links-style layout with panoramic views of Lake Sakakawea is a challenge for golfers of all skill levels. Water isn't a factor but 70-80 grass bunkers are.

Central North Dakota

Birchwood Golf Course

One of the most scenic golf courses in the state, Birchwood is located at Lake Metigoshe in the heart of the Turtle Mountains, just a 7-iron away from the Canadian border. Drive the green on the first hole (270 yards) and your golf round is free!

CrossRoads Golf Course

A Golf Digest Four Star Award winner, this 18-hole, par-72 course includes a clubhouse and scenic 5-mile bike path.

This affordable course offers 18 challenging holes set along the shores of local fishermen's haven Devils Lake

12 Hawktree Golf Club

The Golf Digest-recognized Scottish Links style course combines elevation changes and beautiful scenery for an unforgettable day on the course.

13 Jamestown Country Club

This tree-lined course in North Dakota's open prairie boasts an 18-hole, par-72 championship layout that manages to be both challenging and relaxing for golfers.

Painted Woods Golf Course

Great views, challenging holes - many with water to contend with - and undulating greens make this 18-hole, par-36 layout a true test.

B Riverwood Golf Course

A challenging 18-hole, par-72 layout in the cottonwoods along the Missouri River, this 7,000-yard course is a true test of shot-making skills. Look for deer in the quiet solitude of the woods.

15 Souris Valley Golf Course

Situated along the Souris River, this course tests every part of your game. The river winds throughout the course, and you will cross it about a half-dozen times during your round.

Eastern North Dakota

D Bois de Sioux Golf Course

The only public golf course in the nation to have nine holes in one state and nine holes in another, the front side of this course is in Wahpeton, ND while the back side is in Breckenridge, MN.

18 Bjornson Park Golf Course

Just off the Sheyenne River Valley National Scenic Byway on the south side of I-94, this beautiful course follows the winding Sheyenne River.

10 Cavalier Country Club 9355 135th Avenue NE

No tee times are needed on this scenic 9-hole, par-36 course. Take your time and enjoy the landscape - several of the greens and tee boxes offer views of Lake Renwick's calm waters.

20 Edgewood Golf Course

Established in the mid-1920s, this 18-hole, par-72 course is a popular traditional type golf course in the Fargo area, situated along the Red River with beautiful, tree-lined fairways.

a Forman Golf Course

A mature course of 30-plus years, it features one of the hardest finishing holes in the state.

22 King's Walk

This Arnold Palmer Signature Champion Golf Course is characterized with mounds, moguls, native grasses and pine trees interspersed with lakes styled in a dry southwestern arroyo landscape.

23 Lincoln Golf Course

One of North Dakota's oldest 9-hole golf courses, its picturesque setting along the Red River was renovated after the Flood of 1997.

24 Rose Creek Golf Course

Rose Creek, a Richard Phelps designed course, was recently recognized by Golf Digest as a "Best Places to Play." It features four sets of tees, generous landing areas and large bentgrass greens.
