Medora is the gateway to the South Unit of Theodore Roosevelt National Park and the Great America West. This authentic, real-life western cowtown was founded in 1883 by a French nobleman, the Marquis de Mores, and named it for his wife. Medora offers a musical extravaganza, trail rides, mountain biking, hiking, museums, many gift shops, spa and restaurants during the summer season.

CHATEAU de MORES STATE HISTORIC SITE

Elegant 26-room home of famous French nobleman who founded Medora. Built in 1883, it is one of the three mansions on the prairie.
