- Care for our sacred buffalo and understand our connection with this majestic animal
- Build a tipi and explore our tribe's cultural heritage
- Learn about modern day life as a D/Lakota person and our tribal governance
- Listen to traditional stories from tribal Elders
- Star gaze under the prairie skies and journey through the D/Lakota constellations
- Hear the account of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe's stand against the oil pipeline transgressions
